ORAL ORDER

4 14-03-2023 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection with Nayaram Nagar P.S. Case No.119 of 2022 registered under Section 7 of the Essential Commodities Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this case due to political vendetta. The shop of the petitioner (P.D.S. Dealer) was inspected at night without any complaint and found shortage of food grains which has already been distributed to the beneficiaries.

Having considered the above facts and the submissions advanced on behalf of the parties, let the above



named petitioner be released on bail, in the event of arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of four weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of S.D.J.M., Munger in connection with Nayaram Nagar P.S. Case No.119 of 2022, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
