the following relief:-

“1. That this is an application for quashing the F.I.R bearing Paru P.S. Case No 183/2013 whereby prosecution has been initiated against the petitioner on the allegation of although the petitioner having been transferred from the office of the BDO Paru to the District Land Accusation Office, Muzaffarpur and had also given his joining to the new destination has not handed over the charge to his new incumbent. Thus the BDO opined that by not handing over the charge of Nazir in the office of



B.D.O Paru, the petitioner seemed to have misappropriated funds and has committed irregularity in Rokad Bahi."

2. At the outset, the learned senior counsel for the petitioner seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to file appropriate discharge petition and/or raise all the issues raised in the present petition before the learned Trial Court at an appropriate stage. Liberty, so sought, is granted.
