appearing on behalf of the petitioner and Mr. Bharat Bhushan,

learned APP for the State.

2. The petitioner seeks pre-arrest bail in connection

with Sour Bazar P.S. Case No. 206 of 2021 registered for the

offence punishable under Sections 304(B), 120(B) and 201/34

of the Indian Penal Code.

3. The allegation is of committing murder of the

daughter of the informant by her in-laws including the petitioner

for non-fulfillment of demand of dowry.

4. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the

petitioner submitted that the petitioner is innocent and he has

committed no offence as alleged in the F.I.R.. Petitioner is distant agnate of the son-in-law of the informant namely Akhilesh Sada and he has no concern with the family affairs of said Akhilesh Sada who is the husband of the deceased. Due to enmity, he has been named in the F.I.R. No specific allegation has been levelled against him. Similarly situated co-accused namely Sudha Devi and Mahendra Sada have been released on anticipatory bail by this Court vide order dated 19.08.2023 passed in C.W.J.C. No. 52292 of 2023.

5. Learned APP for the State has vehemently opposed the prayer for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner.

6. Considering the nature of allegation levelled against the petitioner and the fact that similarly situated co-accused namely Sudha Devi and Mahendra Sada have been released on anticipatory bail by this Court vide order dated 19.08.2023 passed in C.W.J.C. No. 52292 of 2023, the petitioner, above named, is directed to be released on pre-arrest bail, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the Court below within a period of four weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Saharsa in connection with Sour Bazar P.S.

Case No. 206 of 2021, subject to the condition as laid down
under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
