*nature of mandamus and commanding the respondents for vacating the encroachment from the Ramgarhwa (Sabji Bazar) bearing Khata no.-17 Plot No. 1202 Area-0.75 decimal of Land. The aforesaid land is under Gairmajarua of the concern locality.*

*II. For direction to the Government authority, Respondent 1st set for discharging their duties as proper and fair for the ends of justice."*

2. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to approach the Circle Officer, Ramgarhwa, District-East Champaran, for redressal of his aforesaid grievances. Liberty so sought is granted.

It is needless to state that in case, the petitioner approaches the Circle Officer, Ramgarhwa, District-East Champaran, by filing appropriate petition under the provisions of the Bihar Public Land Encroachment Act, 1956, within a period of four weeks from today, the same shall be considered, in accordance with law and after



hearing the affected parties, appropriate orders shall be passed thereon, forthwith.
