2 10-10-2023 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

2. The petitioner apprehends his arrest in a case registered
for the offence punishable u/s 302, 307, 354(B), 341, 323, 324,
147 of the IPC.

3. Allegedly, all the F.I.R. named accused persons including
the petitioner armed variously came to the house of informant
and started assaulting the father of the informant and when the
cousin of the informant came for rescue, he was also assaulted.
Father of the informant died in the way to hospital.

4. It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that
petitioner is quite innocent and has committed no offence. He
has been falsely implicated in this case. No such occurrence, in



the manner as alleged, has ever taken place. The allegation leveled against the petitioner is not specific rather general and omnibus in nature. There is case and counter-case between the parties. It is further submitted that after investigation, police submitted final form against the petitioner and others but the learned Court below differing with the final form, took cognizance against the petitioner and others. Petitioner has no criminal antecedent.

5. Learned APP for the State opposed the prayer for bail.

6. Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, let the above named petitioner, be released on bail, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below where the case is pending/Successor Court in connection with Kumarkhand P.S. Case No.71/2023, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
