ORAL ORDER

8 22-06-2023 Heard the parties.

The writ petition was filed against the order passed by the Municipal Corporation directing the petitioner to demolish the construction of Survey Plot No. 144, Ward No. 13 Old/38 New Circle No. 20, Holding No. 69 situated at Rajendra Path, Kadamkuan, Patna.

It has been submitted by learned Counsel for the respondent nos. 4 and 5 as also the Municipal Corporation that the appeal against the said order is already pending before the Municipal Building Tribunal-02 vide Appeal No. 04(S) of 2018



and the last date of hearing was 5th of June, 2023 in which the parties are appearing.

In the aforesaid background, the writ petition stands disposed of with a direction to the Municipal Building Tribunal-02 to take decision in the matter after hearing all the concerned preferably within a period of three months.

Till an order is passed by the Municipal Building Tribunal-02, the status-quo that was granted by a co-ordinate bench on 31.07.2019 to continue.

Accordingly, the writ petition stands disposed of.
