2 12-09-2023 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

2. The petitioner has prayed for regular bail in a case
instituted for the offence under Section 392 of the Indian Penal
Code.

3. As per prosecution case, some unknown miscreants
stepped down from motorcycle and on the point of pistol looted
cash of Rs. 72,000/-, bio-metric machine, mobile and
motorcycle of the informant thereafter the miscreants fled away.

4. It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner
that petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case. He has
committed no offence. Petitioner is not named in the FIR and
the same has been lodged against unknown persons. The name
of the petitioner has come into light, on the basis of confessional



statement of co-accused Amit Kumar Sharma, which has got no evidentiary value in the eyes of law. Nothing incriminating/looted articles have been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. No T.I. Parade has been done. Petitioner has been remanded in this case on 27.03.2023 and since then he is languishing in judicial custody.

5. The application for bail is opposed by learned APP for the State.

6. Having heard learned counsel for the parties and considering the facts and circumstances of the case as well as period of custody, this court is inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail. The above named petitioner is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rs. ten thousand only) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Court below in connection with Laukaria P.S. Case No. 4 of 2022.
