4 11-01-2023 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned counsel appearing on behalf of the State. Learned counsel for the informant is also present.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection with Chakai P.S. Case No. 229/2019 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 406 and 420 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the informant has appeared and filed an affidavit sworn by the informant. In the affidavit, it has been stated that the petitioner has returned the amount to the informant and the informant has no other grievance.



Considering the facts and circumstances, the present anticipatory bail application is allowed.
