counsel for the State.

Petitioner apprehends arrest in connection with
Koilar P.S. Case No. 526 of 2021 registered for the offence
under sections 406, 409, 420 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
entire amount said to have been collected from the students as
examination fee and admission fee was kept by the informant
himself and got the signature of the petitioner on attendance
register and daily collection register by putting pressure upon
the petitioner. As a matter of fact, the petitioner has deposited all
the defalcated money as would be evident from the documents
contained in Annexure-2 (series). Petitioner has no criminal



antecedent.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and the submissions advanced on behalf of the parties, the petitioner, above named, is directed to be released on bail on furnishing personal bond to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate Bhojpur, Ara in connection with Koilwar P.S. Case No. 526 of 2021 subject to the conditions as laid down under section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
