ORAL ORDER

3 24-03-2023 Heard the parties.

The petitioner apprehend his arrest in a case registered for the offence punishable under Sections 341, 323, 498(A), 506 of the Indian Penal Code and section 3/4 of D.P Act.

The allegation against the petitioner is that he alongwith his family members assaulted and tortured the informant on the pretext of non-fulfillment of demand for dowry.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that petitioner is quite innocent and have committed no offence. He has been falsely implicated in this case. No such occurrence, in the manner as alleged, has ever taken place. The allegation levelled against the petitioner is not specific rather general and omnibus in nature. He further submits that there is a



compromise between the parties, as also evident from the supplementary affidavit and this fact is also supported by the learned counsel for the informant. Petitioner has no criminal antecedent.

Learned APP for the State opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail.

Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, let the above named petitioner, be released on bail, in the event of his/her arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below where the case is pending/Successor Court in connection with Barhara P.S. Case No.385 of 2021, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
