7 05-05-2023 Heard learned counsel for the parties.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in a case registered for the offence under Sections 363/376/366(A)/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

It is submitted on behalf of petitioner that the victim, in her statement recorded under Section 164 Cr.P.C. (Annexure-3), has categorically stated that she has left the house out of her own sweat will and thereafter, married with this petitioner in a temple and now, she wants to live with him. Petitioner claims clean antecedent.

Considering the statement of the victim recorded under Section 164 Cr.P.C., in the event of arrest/surrender within a period of six weeks from today, let the above named petitioner be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs.



10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Additional District & Sessions Judge-VI-cum-Special Judge (POCSO), Sitamarhi (*as per statement made in supplementary affidavit*) in connection with Runnisaidpur P.S. Case No. 134 of 2017, subject to condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
