2 04-09-2023 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and the State.

2. Petitioners apprehend arrest in a case registered for the offence punishable under sections 307/379/504/506/34 and other ancillary sections of the Indian Penal Code.

3. As per the prosecution case, specific allegation of assault is against co-accused Rakesh Yadav and there is general and omnibus allegation against these petitioners. Moreover, parties are agnate and have subsisting partition dispute between them. Petitioners claim clean antecedent.

4. Considering the aforesaid facts of the case, prayer for bail of all the petitioners is allowed. In the event of



arrest/surrender within six weeks from today, let these petitioners, mentioned above, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate II, Gaya in Barachatti Police Station Case No. 302 of 2023, subject to the conditions laid down under section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
