APP for the State.

2. The petitioner has prayed for regular bail in a case registered for the offence punishable under sections 302/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

3. As per prosecution case, the informant alleged that the petitioner along with others are indulged in hatching conspiracy to cause death of his son namely, Saurabh Kumar.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is innocent and has committed no offence. He has falsely been implicated in this case on the basis of suspicion. As a matter of fact, it was the petitioner who had taken the deceased to hospital. No one is eye witnesses of the alleged occurrence. During course of investigation, no any consistent



evidence has come against the petitioner. Other co-accused namely, Ram Samejan Pandey has already been granted anticipatory bail by a co-ordinate Bench of this Court vide order dt. 26.9.2022 passed in Cr. Misc. No. 837 of 2022 in support of this, Annexure-2 has been annexed with the petition. It is further submitted that the petitioner is languishing in judicial custody since 10.4.2023.

5. Learned APP appearing for the state has opposed the prayer of regular bail.

6. Having heard learned counsel for the parties and considering the facts and circumstances of the case as well as custody of the petitioner, this court is inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail. The above named petitioner is directed to be released on bail in connection with Kanti P.S. Case No. 481 of 2021 on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned A.C.J.M.-II, Muzaffarpur, West.
