ORAL ORDER

10 06-11-2023 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned APP
for the State.

2. Vide order dated 16.03.2023, notice was issued upon
the O.P. No.2 and the said notice has been received by the sister
and father of the O.P. No.2. They have stated that marriage of
O.P. No.2 has been solemnized with another person.

3. The petitioner apprehends his arrest in a case
registered for the offences punishable under Section 341, 323,
498A, 34 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 3/4 of the Dowry
Prohibition Act.

4. Petitioner, who is husband of opposite party no2., is
said to have ousted the opposite party no.2 from her



matrimonial home in association of his family members over the dowry demand.

5. It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner is an innocent person and has committed no offence. Petitioner has neither made any dowry demand nor drove her out of her matrimonial home nor tormented her over the demand of dowry. The petitioner has relied upon the judgment of this Court in the case of **Md. Naimul Haque Ansari @ Naimul Haque Ansari & Ors. Vs. The State of Bihar**, reported in **2006 (3) PLJR 182**.

6. In that view of the matter, let the above named petitioner, be released on bail, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Court below where the case is pending/successor Court in connection with Dighwara P.S. Case No.27 of 2022, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Cr.P.C.,

7. If so advised, either of the parties will be at liberty to make an application before the learned Court below for referring the matter to the District Mediation Center for the purpose of



reconciliation or for one time settlement.

8. Accordingly, this application stands disposed of.
