APP for the State.

The petitioner has filed the instant application for grant of regular bail in connection with Barauli P.S. Case No. 229 of 2021 registered under sections 395 and 397 of the Indian Penal Code.

Prosecution case in brief is that the informant is running CSP of Central Bank of India, on the date of occurrence, four miscreants armed with weapon came and looted Rs. one lakh and three mobiles from there and fled away after firing.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is innocent and has committed no offence. He has falsely been implicated in this present case. The petitioner is not



named in F.I.R. rather his name has been transpired in this case from Barauli P.S. Case No. 249 of 2021 on the basis of his self confessional statement, and after that he has been remanded in this case. Neither anything incriminating or stolen article has been recovered from his possession nor he has been put on T.I.P. He is languishing in judicial custody since 23.09.2021.

The application for bail is vehemently opposed by learned APP for the State.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties and taking into consideration the facts and circumstances of the case, the Court is inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail. The above named petitioner is directed to be enlarged on bail in connection with Barauli P.S. Case No. 229 of 2021 on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Additional Sessions Judge-I Gopalganj.
