APP for the State.

2. The petitioner has prayed for regular bail in a case
instituted for the offence under Sections 364A, 395 and 397 of
the Indian Penal Code.

3. The allegation against the petitioner along with
others is of committing kidnapping during the course of dacoity,
where victim rescued by police during the course of kidnapping
itself, arresting three co-accused persons.

4. It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner
that petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case. He has
committed no offence. Petitioner is not named in the FIR. The
name of the petitioner has come into light, on the basis of



confessional statement of co-accused Md. Meeraj, which has got no evidentiary value in the eyes of law. Nothing incriminating/looted articles have been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. He further submitted that the other co-accused has already been granted bail by a Co-ordinate Bench vide order dated 26.06.2023 passed in Cr. Misc. No. 34314 of 2023. He is languishing in judicial custody since 30.08.2022.

5. The application for bail is opposed by learned APP for the State.

6. Having heard learned counsel for the parties and considering the facts and circumstances of the case as well as period of custody, this court is inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail. The above named petitioner is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rs. ten thousand only) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Court below in connection with Industrial Area P.S. Case No. 111 of 2022.
