Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that Annexure-P/8 series being the representations filed by the petitioners for a particular pay-scale is required to be considered



by the respondent authorities.

The situation does not require any adjudication in the instant proceeding as the claim of the petitioners for parity with others is required to be considered by the Principal, Jawaharlal Nehru Medical College, Bhagalpur (respondent No. 4).

The writ application, therefore, is disposed of with a direction to the Respondent No. 4 to take a decision on petitioners’ representation dated 27.07.2023 (Annexure-P/8 series), by a reasoned and speaking order within three months from the date of receipt/production of a copy of this order.
