The report of learned 21st Additional Sessions

Judge, East Champaran, Motihari dated 21.03.2023

suggests that out of nine prosecution witnesses, eight

witnesses have already been examined and only I.O is

yet to be examined for which summon has already been

issued for his appearance.



In that view of the matter, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the petition.

Permission is accorded.

Accordingly, the petition is dismissed as withdrawn.

The Trial Court is directed to expedite the trial and conclude the same within a period of three months from today.
