7 02-02-2023 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner no. 2 and learned counsel for the State.

The petitioner no. 2 apprehends her arrest in connection with Aadapur P.S. Case No. 122 of 2021 registered under Sections 304(B) and 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner no. 2 submits that petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in the present case. Further submission is that petitioner is mother-in-law of the deceased and no specific allegation against her. He also submits that the husband of the deceased is already under custody. Petitioner has got no criminal antecedent.



Having considered the facts and circumstances of the case, let the petitioner no. 2, namely, Laalpari Devi be released on bail, in the event of arrest or surrender before the learned court below within a period of four weeks from today, on furnishing personal bond to the satisfaction of the Judicial Magistrate-I, Raxaul, East Champaran in connection with Aadapur P.S. Case No. 122 of 2021, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr. P.C.
