2 03-01-2023 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned APP
for the State.

Petitioner is apprehending his arrest in connection with
Bettiah Mufassil P.S. Case No.295 of 2022, registered for the
offence u/s 341, 323, 324, 307, 354(B), 379, 504 read with
section 34 of the IPC.

Allegedly, the F.I.R. named accused persons including the
petitioner is said to have assaulted the informant's side by
means of various weapons due to a land dispute.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that
petitioner is quite innocent and has committed no offence. He
has been falsely implicated in this case due to the admitted land
dispute. No such occurrence in the manner as alleged has ever



taken place. Petitioner and informant are the own brothers and there is admitted land dispute between them. Petitioner has one criminal antecedent.

Learned APP for the State opposed the prayer for bail by submitting that there is specific allegation against the petitioner and the injury sustained by the informant was found to be grievous in nature.

Considering that the injury of informant is grievous in nature, I am not inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail. The prayer for grant of anticipatory bail on his behalf is rejected.

This application is accordingly dismissed.
