2 10-05-2023 The present writ petition has been filed
seeking the following relief:-

*"That the petitioner prays for
issuance of an appropriate writ / writs,
order / orders, direction / directions for
taking appropriate action against
respondent no. 9 in the light of enquiry
committee report dated 04.07.2022 by
which he has been found guilty of*



misconduct on his part and has been recommended for transfer and appropriate action for the alleged occurrence.

The petitioner further prays for direction to the District Magistrate for conducting a fresh enquiry against the respondent no. 9 on the basis of complaint made by the respondent no. 8 regarding the financial irregularity and misconduct by the respondent no. 9."

At the outset, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks not to press the present writ petition, however, seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to avail such other alternative remedies as are otherwise available under the law. Liberty, so sought, is granted.

The writ petition stands dismissed as not pressed.
