2. The petitioner has prayed for regular bail in a case registered for the offence punishable under sections 406, 407/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

3. As per prosecution case, the informant alleged that co-accused Sadhu Yadav went to Delhi from Patna by truck loaded with scrap of power grid. When the informant tried to contact him, he did not trace out. After that, the said truck was recovered but power grid is missing. Accordingly, present case has been lodged.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is innocent and has committed no offence. The petitioner is not named in the FIR rather his name was



transpired in this case on the basis of confession made by co-accused Sadhu Yadav. Nothing has been recovered from conscious possession of the petitioner. Except suspicion, no any material has come on record against the petitioner. The petitioner has got no criminal antecedent as stated in para-3 of the bail petition. It is further submitted that the petitioner is languishing in judicial custody since 10.7.2023.

5. Learned APP appearing for the state has opposed the prayer of regular bail.

6. Having heard learned counsel for the parties and considering the facts and circumstances of the case as well as custody of the petitioner, this court is inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail. The above named petitioner is directed to be released on bail in connection with Kiul P.S. Case No. 67 of 2023 on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Lakhisarai.
