ORAL ORDER

2 07-02-2023 Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and
learned APP for the State.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest for the offences alleged under Sections 341, 323, 504, 506, 307 and 498(A)/34 of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 3 and 4 of the D.P.Act, registered in connection with Bhojpur Mahila P.S.Case No. 64 of 2022.

As per allegation, the accused persons tortured the victim for non-fulfilment of demand of dowry.

The learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is *Devar* of the informant having no concern with day-to-day affairs of the couple.

On the other hand, the learned APP has opposed the



prayer for anticipatory bail.

Considering the above facts and circumstances, let the petitioner above-named, in the event of his arrest or surrender within four weeks from the date of communication of this order, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/-(ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Sub-divisional Judicial Magistrate Bhojpur, Ara in connection with Bhojpur Mahila P.S.Case No. 64 of 2022, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr. P.C.
