4 20-04-2023 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
counsel for the State.

Petitioner apprehends arrest in connection with
Chandauti P.S. Case No. 101 of 2021 registered for the offence
under sections 341, 323, 504, 506, 498A/34 of the Indian Penal
code and section 3/4 of the Dowry Prohibition Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that
petitioner has not committed any offence as alleged in the first
information report. Petitioner never demand any dowry nor
tortured the informant ever. Petitioner undertakes to give Rs.
2000/- per month to the informant for her maintenance, as stated
in paragraph 3 of the supplementary affidavit. Petitioner has no
criminal antecedent.



Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and the submissions advanced on behalf of the parties, the petitioner, above named, is directed to be released on bail on furnishing personal bond to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate, Gaya in connection with Chandauti P.S.
