ORAL ORDER

2 08-02-2023 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as
learned APP for the State.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection with Laxmipur P.S. Case No. 157 of 2022, registered for the offences punishable under Sections 147, 341, 323, 307, 354(B), 379, 504 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code.

As per allegation, when the grandson of the informant touched the motorcycle of the petitioner, he abused him and all the named accused persons assaulted the informant and his wife.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the FIR shows itself that the dispute arose on trivial issue. The injuries are simple in nature and the petitioner is a person of clean antecedent.



Considering the above-mentioned facts and circumstances, let the petitioner, in the event of his arrest or surrender within four weeks before the learned court below, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Sri Sanjeev Kumar, learned Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Jamui in connection with Laxmipur P.S. Case No. 157 of 2022, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
