“1. That this application is being filed for
Commanding Directing the respondents to ensure
payment of all the admissible dues viz. pay and
allowances for the duty period 01.09.2006 to
19.09.2006, differential arrear admissible
between 01.04.2007 to 20.10.2008 in view of
Vith Pay Revision, statutory /penal interest over
the medical reimbursement on Account of
delayed payment, security money towards pass
book etc. in favour of the petitioner who
