ORAL ORDER

3 18-12-2023 Heard the parties.

2. The petitioner apprehends his arrest in a case registered for the offence punishable under Sections 304B, 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

3. Allegedly, the petitioner demanded dowry from the informant's daughter due to which she got depressed and committed suicide.

4. It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that petitioner is quite innocent and have committed no offence. He has been falsely implicated in this case. No such occurrence, in the manner as alleged, has ever taken place. The allegation levelled against the petitioner is not specific rather general and omnibus in nature. There is no specific overt act against the petitioner. He submits that the deceased committed suicide by



hanging herself in her *mai*ke. The petitioner is presently posted in C.R.P.F. at Bijapur, Chattisgarh and at the time of occurrence he was posted at CTC-Neemuch, Madhya Pradesh and he had been sent for physical training for twelve weeks (Annexure-3). Petitioner has no criminal antecedent.

5. Learned APP for the State as well as learned counsel for the informant opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail.

6. Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case as there is no specific overt act against the petitioner, let the above named petitioner, be released on bail, in the event of his/her arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below where the case is pending/Successor Court in connection with Sare P.S. Case No.39 of 2022, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
