4 06-02-2023 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and the
learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioners apprehend arrest in connection with
Guraru P.S. Case No. 76 of 2022 registered under Sections 341,
323 and 308/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the
petitioners submits that petitioners are innocent and have falsely
been implicated in the present case due to previous enmity.
There is no specific allegation against the petitioners. Further he
submits that the nature of injuries are found simple in nature, as
contained in Annexure-2 to the bail application.

Having considered the facts and circumstances of the



case, let the above named petitioners be released on bail, in the event of arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of four weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Judicial Magistrate-I, Gaya in connection with Guraru P.S. Case No. 76 of 2022, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr. P.C.
