APP for the State.

2. The petitioner has prayed for regular bail in a case registered for the offence punishable under section 394 of the Indian Penal Code.

3. As per prosecution case, while the informant was returning his village, meanwhile, four unknown miscreants intercepted him and snatched his motorcycle along with bag containing cash, mobile and other articles.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is innocent and has committed no offence. The petitioner is not named in the FIR rather his self confession was recorded in Manjhgarh P.S. Case No. 169 of 2022 and on the basis of which, he has made an accused in the present case.



Neither the petitioner was put on TI Parade nor any incriminating article has been recovered from his conscious possession. It is further submitted that the confession before police is not admissible in the eye of law. Moreover, the petitioner is languishing in judicial custody since 27.7.2023.

5. Learned APP appearing for the state has opposed the prayer of regular bail.

6. Having heard learned counsel for the parties and considering the facts and circumstances of the case as well as custody of the petitioner, this court is inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail. The above named petitioner is directed to be released on bail in connection with Rasulpur P.S. Case No. 198 of 2022 on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned J.M. 1st Class, Saran.
