3 27-02-2023 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

Petitioner seeks bail in a case registered for the
offences punishable under Sections 147, 148, 149, 323, 307, 504
of the Indian Penal Code and Section 27 of the Arms Act.

Allegation against the petitioner is that he opened gun
fire sustaining injury on the thigh of the informant.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner is innocent and he has been falsely implicated in the
present case He further submits that due to election the present
occurrence had taken place and the allegation against the
petitioner that he opened fire upon the informant but it appears
from the injury report that the injury is simple in nature and the
injury inflicted not on the vital part of the body of the informant



and the cause of injury by firearm and the opinion is reserved and the police after investigation submitted chargesheet against the petitioner and the petitioner is in custody since 30.08.2022.

Learned APP for the State has opposed the prayer for bail of the petitioner and submits that the petitioner carries one more case other than the present one in which he is on bail.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court below where the case is pending in connection with Sheikhpura (Sirari O.P.) P.S. Case No. 280 of 2022, with the following conditions :-

(1) Petitioner shall co-operate in the trial and shall be properly represented on each and every date fixed by the Court and shall remain physically present as directed by the Court and on his absence on two consecutive dates without sufficient reason, his bail bond shall be cancelled by the Court below.

(2) If the petitioner tampers with the evidence or the witness, in that case, the prosecution will be at liberty to move for cancellation of bail.

(3) And, further condition that the court below shall verify the criminal antecedent of the petitioner and in case at any stage, it is found that the petitioner has concealed his criminal



antecedents, the court below shall take step for cancellation of bail bond of the petitioner. However, the acceptance of bail bonds in terms of the above-mentioned order shall not be delayed for purpose of or in the name of verification.
