2 20-02-2023 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

The petitioner has filed the instant application for
grant of regular bail in connection with K.Hat (Maranga) P.S.
Case No. 383 of 2022 registered under sections 461, 379 and
411 of the Indian Penal Code.

Prosecution case relates to theft in the two different
shops in which from the first shop, one mobile, some electronic
equipment along with Rs. 4700/- and from the other shop, some
general items and Rs.2700/- were missing.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner is innocent and has committed no offence. He has
falsely been implicated in this case due to personal grudge. It is



further submitted that the petitioner is not named in F.I.R. rather his name came into light in this case on the basis of confessional statement of other co-accused person, namely, Chandan Kumar. Nothing has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner and also he has not been put on T.I.P. He is languishing in judicial custody since 22.04.2022.

The application for bail is vehemently opposed by learned APP for the State.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties and taking into consideration the facts and circumstances of the case, the Court is inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail. The above named petitioner is directed to be enlarged on bail in connection with K.Hat (Maranga) P.S. Case No. 383 of 2022 on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned C.J.M., Purnia.
