- (i) To quash the decision of the 'Departmental Tender Committee' of road construction department relating to the work i.e. W & S of Ramgadhwa Thane chowk to Piparpati Ghat Road in K.M 0.00 to 7.20, made on 22.05.2019 in respect of the others two bidders i.e. M/s Naraini Nirman and Pristine Engicon Pvt. Ltd., by which both of them have been illegally declared successful in the technical bid, whereas, the petitioner is the only successful bidder in the technical bid regarding the aforesaid work as per the terms of the 'Standard Bidding Document'.
- (ii) To direct the respondent to award the contract of the said work to the Petitioner as he being the only successful bidder in technical bid and his financial bid is eligible for consideration.
- (iii) For any other relief/reliefs, which may be found appropriate in this facts and circumstances of this case.
