2 19-06-2023 Though the present writ petition has been filed for quashing the order dated 09.05.2022, passed by the First Appellate Authority-cum-Commissioner, Saran Division, Chapra in Case No.416110106122103592/1A, however, considering the fact that no adverse order has been passed against the petitioner and the dispute, in the present case, pertains to the private persons namely Md. Ijrail and Ravindra Yadav, trying to encroach the land of the petitioner, although one title suit bearing Title Suit No.106 of 1992 is



pending before the learned Court of Munsif, 1st Siwan pertaining to the land in question, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to pursue his remedies before the learned Civil Court. Liberty so sought is granted.
