7 18-09-2023 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and

learned A.P.P appearing on behalf of the State.

The petitioner is languishing in custody in a
case registered for the offences punishable under
Sections 25(1-B) a, 26 of the Arms Act.

There is recovery of one country made pistol
and two live cartridges on the confessional of the
petitioner from the house of co-accused Jai Prakash
Kisku.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the
petitioner that petitioner is innocent and he has falsely
been implicated in this case. Nothing has been recovered



from the conscious possession of the petitioner. The petitioner has no concern with the seized arms. The petitioner is languishing in custody since 15.05.2022.

In contra, learned A.P.P appearing on behalf of the State has vehemently opposed the prayer for bail of the petitioner.

Considering the facts aforesaid and the period under custody, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousands) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Banka in connection with Belhar P.S. Case No. 184 of 2022.
