APP for the State.

2. The petitioner has prayed for regular bail in a case registered for the offence punishable under section 392 of the Indian Penal Code.

3. Allegation against the co-accused persons along with this petitioner is that they snatched Rs. 20,000/- from the informant. This petitioner was arrested on spot with the as alleged said money and others co-accused managed to flee from the place of occurrence.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is innocent and has committed no offence. He has falsely been implicated in this case. It is further submitted from para-6 of this petition that the said money which was recovered



from the petitioner, belongs to the petitioner itself as the said money was for the treatment of his father-in-law who is suffering from multiple disease. Nothing consistent evidence has come against the petitioner to implicate in this case. Moreover, he is languishing in judicial custody since 09.04.2023.

5. Learned APP appearing for the state has opposed the prayer of regular bail.

6. Having heard learned counsel for the parties and considering the facts and circumstances of the case as well as custody of the petitioner, this court is inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail. The above named petitioner is directed to be released on bail in connection with Bhimpur P.S. Case No. 42 of 2023 on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned C.J.M., Supaul.
