APP for the State.

The petitioner has prayed for regular bail in a case registered for the offence punishable under section 392 of the Indian Penal Code.

As per allegation in the FIR, on pistol point three miscreants have snatched mobile phone, bag containing cash and motorcycle of the informant and thereafter, they fled away.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case. Neither the petitioner is named in the FIR not put on TIP. There is no eye witness of the alleged occurrence. Nothing has been recovered from his conscious possession of the petitioner. Petitioner is languishing in judicial custody since 16.5.2023.



The application for bail is opposed by learned APP for the State and submitted that petitioner is having three criminal antecedents.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties and considering the facts and circumstances of the case, this court is inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail. The above named petitioner is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rs. ten thousand only) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned CJM, Begusarai in connection with Teghra P.S. Case No. 117 of 2023.
