APP for the State.

2. The petitioner has prayed for regular bail in a case registered for the offence punishable under section 392 of the Indian Penal Code.

3. As per prosecution case, the informant alleged that there miscreants riding on a motorcycle surrounded him and one Neeraj Kumar thereafter, they snatched cash of Rs. 29860/-, two mobile phones along with a Samsung tab and biometric machine from both of them.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is innocent and has committed no offence. The petitioner is not named in FIR. His name was sprang up in this case on the basis of confession made by co-accused namely,



Nilu Das. Neither the petitioner was put on TI parade nor any incriminating article has been recovered from his conscious possession. The petitioner has got no criminal antecedent as stated in para-3 of the petition. It is further submitted that the petitioner is languishing in judicial custody since 22.6.2023.

5. Learned APP appearing for the state has opposed the prayer of regular bail.

6. Having heard learned counsel for the parties and considering the facts and circumstances of the case as well as custody of the petitioner, this court is inclined to enlarge him on bail. The above named petitioner is directed to be released on bail in connection with Jaipur P.S. Case No. 04 of 2023 on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Banka.
