3 20-02-2023 Heard Mr. Rajesh Ranjan, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner, Ms. Binita Singh, learned counsel for the Bihar Industrial Area Development Authority (hereinafter referred to as the BIADA) and Mr. Wasi Mohammad, learned AC to learned SC 6.

2. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submitted that the industry was running on the basis



of partnership deed by the three partners. It was dissolved subsequently and it was mutually agreed between the partners that petitioner will be the sole propriety of the said industry namely, M/s Vishwakarma Industries.

3. The writ petition is devoid of any merit as the partnership deed has not been brought by the petitioner on record in support of his submission made before this Court. Petitioner may avail remedy before the Managing Director, BIADA.

4. Accordingly, the present writ petition is dismissed.
