2 05-10-2023 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

The petitioner has prayed for regular bail in a case
registered for the offence punishable under section 392 of the
Indian Penal Code.

As per allegation in the FIR, at the time of returning
from haldi ceremony, three miscreants on a motorcycle over
took the informant's bike and on pistol point, looted his
motorcycle, mobile, several documents and cash amount of Rs.
7,000/-.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner
that petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case. Neither
the petitioner is named in the FIR not put on TIP. There is no



eye witness of the alleged occurrence. Nothing has been recovered from his conscious possession. Petitioner was arrested in another case and remanded in the present case on 26.5.2023.

The application for bail is opposed by learned APP for the State.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties and considering the facts and circumstances of the case, this court is inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail. The above named petitioner is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rs. ten thousand only) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned SDJM, Rohtas at Sasaram in connection with Agrer P.S. Case No. 18 of 2023.
