ORAL ORDER

2 21-09-2023 The present writ petition has been filed seeking the following relief:-

“1, That the present writ application is being filed on behalf of the petitioner for issuance of appropriate writ/writs. order/orders in the nature of mandamus for commanding the respondent authorities to consider the case of petitioner for grant of promotion to the post of Superintending Engineer w.e.f. 23.10.1999 to 31.08.2000 i.e. the date from which he had



been officiating the higher post till the date of superannuation and the consequential monetary benefits including pensionary benefits and for any other writ/writs, order/orders which the petitioner may found to be entitled in the facts and circumstances of the case.”

2. After some arguments, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks not to press the present writ petition, however, seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to avail such other alternative remedies as are otherwise available under the law. Liberty, so sought, is granted.

3. The writ petition stands dismissed as not pressed.
