2 18-09-2023 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

The petitioner prayed for regular bail in connection with Laukahi P.S. Case no. 210 of 2023 instituted for the offence under Section 272, 273, 414, 34 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

As per prosecution case, the petitioner along with two motorcycles were apprehended on the spot and from the alleged vehicles and from the motorcycle of the petitioner 72 liters Nepali liquor was recovered.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner has submitted that petitioner is innocent and has



committed no offence. He has falsely been implicated in this present case. He has got no criminal antecedent. The petitioner has no concern with the alleged recovery nor vehicle in question belongs to him. No any incriminating article has been recovered from his conscious possession. It is further submitted that the petitioner is languishing in judicial custody since 02.08.2023.

Learned APP appearing for the State has vehemently opposed the prayer of Bail.

The petitioner is directed to deposit a sum of Rs 5,000/- (Five Thousand) in the District Legal Services Authority of concerned District.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties and considering the facts and circumstances of the case as well as judicial custody, this court is inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail. The above named petitioner is directed to be released on bail in connection with Laukahi P.S. Case no. 210 of 2023 on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Special Judge, Excise Patna.

The bail bonds of the petitioner shall be accepted by the learned court below on showing the receipt of deposit of



Rs. 5,000/- (Rs. Five thousand) by the petitioner in the
account of the concerned DLSA.
