2 11-10-2023 Heard learned counsel for the parties.

2. The petitioner apprehends his arrest in a case registered for the offence under Sections 147, 148, 149, 341, 323, 307, 379, 386, 387, 279, 427 of the Indian Penal Code.

3. As per the prosecution case, while the informant was going to his house alongwith other persons by his car and stopped near Toll plaza for taking tea, in the meantime, all the FIR named accused persons including this petitioner and 10-15 unknown persons came there and abused him and on protest, they became violent and started assaulting informant. It is further alleged that co-accused Gautam Singh snatched gold chain from informant and co-accused Hariom Singh took away his purse. This petitioner is alleged to have dashed the car of the informant.



4. It is submitted on behalf of petitioner that present case is counter blast of Amas P.S. Case No. 132 of 2023, which has been lodged by this petitioner against informant and others. Allegation is general and omnibus and there is no injury report on the record.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State has opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, in the event of arrest/surrender within a period of six weeks from today, let the above named petitioner be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned J.M.1st class, Sherghati, Gaya in connection with Amas P.S. Case No. 133 of 2023, subject to condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
