3. Learned Counsel for the B. N. Mandal University, Madhepura, submits that the writ petitioner had approached this Court for a direction to the University to accept fees and forms for registration and examination of B.Ed. for the sessions 2018-2020. He further submits that by order, dated 03.09.2019, a co-ordinate Bench of this
