ORAL ORDER

2 13-03-2023 Learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to remove defect (s), as pointed out by the office, if any, within a period of four weeks on resumption of physical mode.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned A.P.P for the State.

The petitioner has preferred this application for grant of regular bail in a case registered under section 8, 20 (B) (II) (C) 25, 29 of N.D.P.S. Act.

As per the prosecution case, total 10 kg *Ganja* was recovered beneath the seat of the driver of Mahindra Pickup vehicle bearing registration no. BR-26K-3127.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this



case. The petitioner is the driver of the said vehicle. The seized contraband is more than small quantity but less than commercial quantity. The petitioner has clean antecedent as stated in para 3 of the bail petition. The petitioner is in custody since 03.06.2022.

Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the bail petition of the petitioner.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, the petitioner above-named, is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court concerned, Aurngabad in connection with Daudnagar P.S. Case No. 298 of 2022, with a condition:-

1. The petitioner is directed to remain physically present before the learned Court below on each and every date, failing which on two consecutive dates without reasonable cause, the bail bond of the petitioner is liable to be cancelled.

The application stands allowed.
