ORAL ORDER

- 2 24-11-2023 1. Heard learned counsel for the parties concerned.
2. The present petition has been filed for restoration of a criminal writ petition bearing Cr.W.J.C. no. 410 of 2021, which has stood dismissed on account of non compliance of the peremptory order dated 17.07.2023.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that all the defects have been removed but beyond the peremptory time, granted by this Court, hence, it is submitted that a sympathetic view be taken and the aforesaid writ application be restored to its original file.
