prayed as under :-

*(A) A writ in nature of mandamus or any other
appropriate writ/order/orders/directions commanding the
respondent for the following :-*

*(i) To direct the respondents to credit the
money Rs.236950/- (Two Lakh Thirty Six Thousand Nine
Hundred and Fifty Rupees) in the account of the petitioner
in the pension account No. 11778979566 of S.B.I.
alongwith interest.*

*(ii) To any other relief/reliefs for which the
petitioner entitled for.”*
