Petitioners apprehend their arrest in connection with
Pupri P.S. Case No.232 of 2022 registered under Sections 341,
323, 354, 379, 406, 420, 504/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the
petitioners are innocent and have falsely been implicated in this
case. There is land dispute between the parties. The F.I.R. has
been lodged after one month of the alleged occurrence.
