APP for the State.

2. The petitioner has prayed for regular bail in a case registered for the offence punishable under sections 302 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

3. As per prosecution case, some unknown persons have killed the son of the informant.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is innocent and has committed no offence. He has falsely been implicated in this case. The petitioner is not named in FIR rather his name came into light in this case during investigation. No specific overt act has been attributed against the petitioner. Neither any incriminating article has been recovered from his conscious possession nor any consistent



material has come against him. A statement has been made in para-3 of this petition that the petitioner has got no criminal antecedent. Similarly situated other co-accused persons have already been granted bail by this Court vide Annexure-3 series of this petition. Moreover, the petitioner is languishing in judicial custody since 20.07.2023.

5. Learned APP appearing for the state has opposed the prayer of regular bail.

6. Having heard learned counsel for the parties and considering the facts and circumstances of the case as well as custody of the petitioner, this court is inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail. The above named petitioner is directed to be released on bail in connection with Imamganj P.S. Case No. 76 of 2022 on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned J.M. 1st Class, Sherghati, Gaya.
