6 17-04-2023 Heard learned counsels for the petitioner and the

State.

Petitioner apprehends arrest in case registered for the
offences punishable under Sections 147, 323, 307, 354, 506, 379
and other allied sections of the Indian Penal Code.

As per prosecution case, all the F.I.R. named accused
persons including this petitioner assaulted *Bhaisur* of the
informant by means of *Farsa* as a result of which he sustained
injury.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in the
present case. It is next submitted that due to land dispute,
alleged occurrence took place in which both sides sustained
injury. Case and counter case. Petitioner has got clean



antecedent.

Learned counsel for the State opposes the prayer for bail application and submits that doctor has found the injury to be grievous in nature.

Considering the nature of accusation and grievous injury, prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioner is rejected.
