ORAL ORDER

2 12-01-2023 Heard the parties.

The petitioners apprehend their arrest in a case registered for the offence punishable u/s 341, 323, 324, 354, 379, 307, 504, 506, 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Allegedly, the petitioners along with other FIR named accused persons came to the house of informant and they abused and assaulted the informant's side.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioners that petitioners are quite innocent and have committed no offence. They have been falsely implicated in this case. No such occurrence, in the manner as alleged, has ever taken place. The allegation levelled against the petitioners is not specific rather general and omnibus in nature. It is further submitted that for the



alleged occurrence, there is case and counter-case between the parties. The parties are agnates and land dispute prevails between them. Petitioners have two criminal antecedent, as mentioned at para-2 of the supplementary affidavit. Similarly situated co-accused Janki Devi and Prahlad Singh @ Prahlad Prasad Singh have been granted anticipatory bail by this Court vide order dated 02.01.2023 passed in Cr. Misc. No.57475 of 2022.

Learned APP for the State opposed the prayer for bail.

Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, since similarly situated co-accused have been enlarged on bail, let the above named petitioners, be released on bail, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) **each** with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below where the case is pending/Successor Court in connection with Bhagwanpur P.S. Case No.116 of 2022, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
